

Had Enough Of Flock?

Nothing here is legal advice.

WHY PEOPLE ARE WORRIED

- Watching people without a warrant is not the American way.
- Proof taken without a warrant can be thrown out of court. Then a real danger to our town stays free.
- Lawsuits can cost our community money.
- People have used these systems in bad ways.
- Who checks that this data is safe?

WHAT COULD FIX THIS

- Add to the U.S. Constitution, so our Bill of Rights fits the 21st century.
- Add to the Wyoming Constitution, so our Bill of Rights fits the 21st century.
- Converse County bans Flock type systems.
- Glenrock ends its Flock contract and takes the cameras down.
- Glenrock passes a law that bans Flock type systems.
- Rolling Hills passes a law that bans Flock type systems.

THINGS WE CAN DO

- Go to the meetings where leaders make choices.
- Speak up at the town, the county, and the state.
- Tell people what is going on. Many people have no idea!
- Get other people to help.
- Read the list of WY Registered Lobbyists. Find groups that already push for or against this.
- Ask non-profit groups about legal ways to fight this.
- Find good people to run for office when a seat opens up.
- Look for new laws in other places that ban Flock type systems. One such push was started by Kolton G. Krottinger.
- We could write our own law and let Wyoming voters vote on it. This is called a citizen ballot initiative.
- Ask for public records of what our leaders do each day. Share what you get. It shows how nosy Flock really is.

Say this at the meeting

You get a short turn to speak. Say it plain. Read this out loud if you like.

1. My name is _____. I live in _____.
2. I am here about the Flock cameras.
3. I do not want my town tracked without a warrant.
4. Please end the Flock contract.
5. Thank you for your time.

A sign idea

One legal way to pause some watching may be to stand in front of a Flock camera. Hold a sign that blocks what the camera can see.

GET ON THE AGENDA

Call for an appointment. Slots are a half hour. The agenda is set by noon on the Monday before.

1st and 3rd Tuesday of each month, 7 PM, at Town Hall

Tell the Town Clerk at least one week before the meeting.

Ask for the Flock papers

You are allowed to ask for town papers. Ask the Clerk for these:

- The Flock Safety contract the town signed.
- What it costs, and the date it ends or renews.
- The rules for who may look at the camera data.
- A list of who has looked at that data.
- The Flock Safe List they use now.
- How the Flock system is set up now.
- All the recent Flock searches.
- A list of every device that uses Flock, and the last security check for each one.

In Glenrock, all records requests go through the Town Clerk's office. They can charge you a fee for the copies. Ask what it will cost first.

If the price seems too high, you can ask for help.
